Casper Mountain Fire District conducted a meeting on 2-24-10 calling to order at 1800 hrs. The following topics were discussed:

- **Old Business**
 - Instructor training: A Fire Service Instructor I class is scheduled to be held at the Natrona County Fire District training room at 2800 Pheasant Drive, Casper, WY, on March 22-24. You will be pro-board certified at the end of this class. Instructor is Wyoming State Fire Marshal trainer Richard Embrey. This qualification is required for Fire Officer and to instruct many fire classes.
 - Class times are: Monday, March 22 1300 - 1700
Tuesday, March 23 0800 - 1700
Wednesday March 24 0800- 1200
 - Machine Gun Shoot, June 4,5,6, 2010. Need about four people on firing line each day. If interested let Chief Huber know.
- **New Business**
 - Chief Huber discussed the house that blow up on Cynthia St. If we receive a call for a structure fire and conditions seems strange be aware.
 - Northern Wyoming Wildland Fire School, April 15,16,17,18, 2010.
 - CMFD Required training will be the following:
 - Refresher are April 20 & May 11
 - Shelter Deployment April 27
 - Hazmat May 4.
 - Cody Fire School on the web. Chief Huber believes that Pat has reserved rooms.
- **Training**
 - Wildland Sand Board Scenario. The video Fireline Safety Training was viewed and discussions covered the following:
 - Review live Fireline situation on North Valley Fire video
 - Surviving fire entrapments.
 - Burn over situation.
 - Maintenance records for vehicles may be requested if an accidents occurs

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- The conditions of trees burned in 2006 may pose safety hazards from limbs or trees being blown down during strong winds.
- Command & Operations, communicating leader's intent. Communicating tactics for completing the objective.
- Sand table exercise, Brant explained the scenario and assigned IC to Scott. Each member was assigned a task and had to communicate as if it was a real situation.
- The sand table exercise on the video was viewed.
- A possible communication difficulty was reviewed. What radio frequencies are available?
- How to handle an accident and how would that affect our tactics? How would we handle such a situation?
